LaserWriter IIf/IIg: Downloading Files From Hard Drive (6/93)

TOPIC -----

One of the benefits of the LaserWriter IIf/IIg is connecting an external hard drive which gives one the ability to store "background art" at the printer. No details are given in the Owner's Manual as how to download files or how these files are called upon when printing.

DISCUSSION -----

To utilize this feature of storing and downloading files from a hard drive requires fairly good knowledge of PostScript.

The only way of storing "background art" on a printer's hard disk is through writing (then downloading) PostScript code to access the PostScript file system, along with writing the PostScript code required for the art.
