

LaserWriter Pro: Printing from Windows Over a Network (1/93)

TOPIC -----

Will the Microsoft Windows and MS/DOS drivers included with the LaserWriter Pro printers print over a network (such as Ethernet), or will they only allow printing to the LaserWriter Pro's serial or parallel ports?

DISCUSSION -----

The print drivers included in the LaserWriter Pro Windows diskette alone do not provide the capability of network access (Ethernet, for example) from a PC. These drivers will provide PostScript output from a PC connected through serial or parallel cabling.

To gain direct network access using these drivers, customers need additional network access software. An example of this software is Farallon's PhoneNetPC 3.0, which is part of the PhoneNetTalk PC card. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
