

LaserWriter Pro, HP Emulation Mode: Switching Paper Bins (3/93)

TOPIC -----

How do I switch paper bins on a LaserWriter Pro in HP emulation mode?

DISCUSSION -----

If you want to switch paper bins on a LaserWriter Pro in HP emulation mode, you must send an escape code sequence directly to the printer. One way to do this is to type the escape code sequence into to a text file. This is the HPCL escape code sequence to switch between paper bins:

ESC&l#H

where # is the bin selection value and the letter after the "&" is lowercase L.

0	is the bin	selection	value	for	the	default paper tray.
1	"		"	for	the	upper tray.
2	"		"	for	the	manual feed tray.
4	п		"	for	the	lower tray.
6	"		"	for	the	envelope feeder.

For instance, to select the 500 page cassette (or lower tray), send "ESC&14H" to the printer. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
