This article discusses the system requirements of the LaserWriter Select 300.

DISCUSSION -----

### Compatibility

-----

The LaserWriter Select 300 requires a Macintosh computer with 1MB of RAM, a hard disk, System 6.0.7 or later, and the TrueType INIT (startup program). For best performance, Apple recommends at least 2MB of RAM for System 6.07 and 6.08 users, or 4MB RAM for System 7 users.

The LaserWriter Select 300 can use Adobe Type 1 and TrueType fonts, including fonts in a two-byte format. Adobe Type 1 fonts require the presence of Adobe Type Manager.

### Performance

-----

The LaserWriter Select 300 does not have a central processor on its logic board and is dependent on the host Macintosh for page processing. Its performance is directly related to the type of Macintosh used and the complexity of the document. As a general rule, the faster the CPU (microprocessor) and the simpler the document, the faster the LaserWriter Select 300 will print.

To get the best performance from your LaserWriter Select 300, Apple recommends you use a 68020-based Macintosh or faster.
