The LaserWriter Select 300 supports the following operating systems:

- Macintosh System Software 6.0.7 and 6.0.8
- Macintosh System Software 7.0 and later

The LaserWriter Select 300 driver supports these special features: background printing, multiple paper sources, grayscaling, and print density control.

You can select background printing in the Chooser. Note that background printing uses your computer's processing power and may cause your computer to briefly slow down as your document prints.

With an option in the Print Dialog Box, you can select which bin to print from. You can also print the first page of a document from one tray and the rest of the document from a different tray (for example, to print the first page on letterhead paper, and all subsequent pages on plain paper).

The Image setting in the Print Dialog Box allows you to choose between black and white, grayscale, and PhotoGrade printing. (Note that you must add a 4MB memory upgrade to your printer before you can use PhotoGrade.) Documents print faster in black and white than in PhotoGrade or grayscale mode.

The Options selection in the Print Dialog Box contains the Print Density control. The LaserWriter Select 300's print density can be controlled only by software; it has no hardware print density control. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
