LaserWriter Select 310: Printer Drivers (2/95)

This article describes the printer drivers and operating-system compatibility of the LaserWriter Select 310.

DISCUSSION -----

Operating System Support

The LaserWriter Select 310 includes both Macintosh and Microsoft Windows printer driver software.

The following operating systems are supported:

- Macintosh System Software 6.0.7 and 6.0.8
- Macintosh System Software 7.0 and later
- Microsoft Windows 3.0
- Microsoft Windows 3.1

Macintosh Software

The Macintosh LaserWriter driver has been modified to support the features of the LaserWriter Select 310: background printing, multiple paper sources, and the Print Density control. The modified printer driver is the LaserWriter Select 310 printer driver.

You can select background printing in the Chooser. Note that background printing uses your computer's processing power and may cause your computer to briefly slow down as your document prints.

With an option in the Print Dialog Box, you can now select which bin to print from. You can also print the first page of a document from one tray (for example, containing letterhead paper) and the rest of the document from a different tray (for example, containing plain paper).

The Options selection in the Print Dialog Box contains the Print Density control. The LaserWriter Select 310's print density can only be controlled by software; it has no hardware print density control.

Microsoft Windows

The Windows 3.0 and 3.1 drivers allow you to select printer resolution, paper handling and grayscaling options.
