Why does Apple only support PostScript Level I on the LaserWriter Select 310?
DISCUSSION
Apple used PostScript Level I on our LaserWriter Select 310 because overall it's a less expensive solution. Since the printer was geared as an entry-level solution, there were a couple of major reasons for using PostScript Level I:
• PostScript Level II requires more RAM in the printer, and thus would increase the cost of the printer.
