Can I use 60 ns $256K \times 4$ -bit DRAM to upgrade a Personal LaserWriter LS?
DISCUSSION
Yes. The Personal LaserWriter LS specifications state that you can use RAM rated at 100 ns or faster, and 60 ns RAM is faster than 100 ns RAM. Although the RAM is rated faster than 100 ns, it still will be accessed at the 100-ns rate.
