Paper Feed

ullet Automatic up to 100 sheets (fewer sheets if heavier paper is used) or 15 envelopes

Print materials

- Apple recommends 20-lb. (75 g/m2) cotton bond; also accepts 16-lb. (60 g/m2) to 24-lb (90 g/m2) paper
- Paper sizes: U.S. letter, U.S. legal, A4
- Most letterhead and colored stock, labels, envelopes, and transparencies
- Envelopes: #10 business, monarch, and other sizes
- Apple recommends 3M brand CG3480 transparency film

• Multipurpose tray: up to 100 sheets of 20 lb. paper (fewer sheets if heavier paper is used) or 15 envelopes
