

## StyleWriter II: Self Test Prints Blank Page (4/94)

TOPIC
My StyleWriter II will not print from my computer. When I do a self test, it just prints a blank sheet of paper and the error light comes on. Why?
DISCUSSION
Verify the type of cable that is connected the StyleWriter II. Make sure that i is an Apple System Peripheral 8 cable (M0197LL/B) or compatible as described in the StyleWriter II manual. When a network cable, such as a PhoneNet or LocalTal RJ11 Connector, is connected to the printer the symptoms you mentioned appear.
To verify the problem is cable related follow these steps:
<ol> <li>Turn the printer off</li> <li>Unplug the printer cable</li> <li>Press and hold down the printer power button until the yellow light turns off.</li> </ol>
The printer should print a self-test. If it prints the self test, the problem was cable related. If the StyleWriter II does not print a self-test with the cables disconnected, have the printer looked at by an Authorized Apple Service Provider.
