

Printer Description Files: Where to Get Them (8/94)

TOPIC -----

When Apple introduces new printers, will Apple provide application-specific printer description files for third-party software packages such as Quark XPress, Aldus PageMaker, and so on?

DISCUSSION -----

All PPD's are included with the LaserWriter 8.x driver software as well as being available separately. LaserWriter 8.x, is of course the first PostScript Level 2 driver available for all our PostScript Level 2 printers, specifically the LaserWriter IIf, IIg, the LaserWriter Pro 600/630, and most Apple LaserWriter printers released after these.

Adobe Systems Inc. and Apple's Developer Technical Support group have the PPD (PostScript Printer Description) files for all of Apple's printers. These printer description files are available to third-party developers, and it is up to the developers to ask either Apple or Adobe for these PPDs. Once acquired, developers can create their own application-specific PPD files to distribute with their applications.

Some applications don't require specially modified PPD files, and can use the files as is (check with the specific application developer).

Example: Using PPD files with PageMaker 4.2

PageMaker 4.2 can use PPD files directly. The files must have a ".PPD" extension at the end of its file name (that is, LWPRO630.PPD), and the file must reside in:

System Folder Aldus PPDs

The PPD files for all of Apple's LaserWriter printers are posted on AppleLink and other online services.
